Translational Stroke Research

Stroke is a devastating disease mainly affecting the aging population; and its prevalence is on the rise. In Switzerland, roughly 16.000 people suffer a stroke every year.

To combat stroke, new therapeutic approaches are needed, also accounting for the individual vulnerability of the elderly.

The goal of the translational stroke research group is to achieve individualized treatment by advancing precision medicine for patients suffering a stroke. This is achieved by bringing together basic research uncovering mechanisms of cerebrovascular disease with clinical research activities including prospective clinical stroke trials.
